Subject + finite form of to be + Past Participle (3rd column of <u>irregular verbs</u>)

Examples of Passive •••••

Tense		Subject	Verb	Object
Simple	Active:	Rita	writes	a letter.
Present	Passive:	A letter	is written	by Rita.
Simple Past	Active:	Rita	wrote	a letter.
	Passive:	A letter	was written	by Rita.
Present Perfect	Active:	Rita	has written	a letter.
renect	Passive:	A letter	has been written	by Rita.
Future I	Active:	Rita	will write	a letter.
	Passive:	A letter	will be written	by Rita.
Can	Active:	Rita	can write	a letter.
	Passive:	A letter	can be written	by Rita.
